## Yavapai County Precinct Committeemen Censure of Ken Bennett

Ken Bennett was elected by the people of Yavapai County and his actions show a failure to represent his constituency and a disregard for core Republican values.

- Ken Bennett was the only republican in the Arizona State Senate to vote against HCR2032 which would have let voters decide if Arizona should return to precinct polling and if passed it would have been a major step in securing our elections.
- Ken Bennett was the only republican in the Arizona State Senate to vote against Senate Concurrent Resolution 1013 which would have allowed the voters of Arizona to decide if boys are allowed in girl's bathrooms and would have required teachers to obtain permission from a child's parents before using that child's preferred pronouns.
- Ken Bennett was the only Republican in the Arizona State Senate to vote against the "Freedom to Move" bill which would have let the voters of Arizona decide to create a Constitutional ban on taxes or fees for vehicle miles traveled and limitations on miles traveled.

  million dollars.
